








But Only A Quarter Believe That The Worst Of Inflation Is Behind Us




Worst of inflation is still ahead

Now thinking specifically about the following items, do you think prices will continue to increase, stay the same, or decrease in the next few months?





In what part of your daily life do you feel most affected by inflation? Please select all that apply.






How likely or unlikely do you think it is that rising inflation will taper off and decrease by 2024?









Three Months Into 2023 & 7 In 10 Still Say Inflation Is Negatively Impacting Budgets


How much do you agree or disagree that rising inflation is negatively impacting your ability to afford your monthly budget?




How likely are you to do the following right now?

How concerned are you about each of the following due to recent stock market declines?



















Americans Have A Brighter Outlook With Now Over 4 In 10 Optimistic About Their Life Over The Next Year






Most Americans Are Currently Prioritizing Savings And Sticking To Budgets

I am currently prioritizing saving and staying within my budget because of rising inflation





Compared to last month, are you more or less...















Of Those Who Know ChatGPT, 2 In 5 Have Used The Tool Multiple Times

Among those who know what ChatGPT is






Nearly half (46%) of those who said their companies have had discussions about ChatGPT say they were told they could use it if it made them more efficient or productive at work




Which statement do you agree with most when thinking of ChatGPT? Among employed Americans who know what ChatGPT is

The world will be more harmed by ChatGPT




