State of Beyoncé A Study of Fandom Culture

April 2024 • The Harris Poll Thought Leadership Practice



This survey was conducted online within the U.S. by The Harris Poll from March 22nd to 24th, 2023, among a nationally representative sample of 2,043 U.S. adults.

This research is comprised of 1,059 Women and 984 Men, including 204 Gen Z (ages 18-26), 619 Millennials (ages 27-42), 529 Gen X (ages 43-58), and 691 Boomers (ages 59 and older).


The research also includes 1,164 Beyoncé fans. "Fans" are defined as those who selected 5-10 on a 10-point fandom scale (where 1="Not for me," 5="Casual fan," and 1="Member of the BeyHive." Within this, there were also 277 "BeyHive" superfans, defined as those who either selected 10 in the 10-point fandom scale, or who say they have called themselves a member of the BeyHive. "All Americans" stands for the U.S. Total and includes both non-fans and fans.



Top Highlights

- *Chart-Topping Adoration*: Six in 10 Americans proudly proclaim themselves Beyoncé fans, with 1 in 7 sworn members of the BeyHive, including a quarter of Millennials.
- Fandom Fervor Unleashed: Six in 10 (58%) BeyHive members would be open to tattooing Beyoncé's name or likeness on themselves.
- **Beyond The Stage**: Over a third of Americans tune into Beyoncé's personal life, while the BeyHive digs deeper, saying they're familiar even with her astrological sign or net worth.
- **Opening Up The Wallets**: Seven in 10 Beyoncé fans plan to splash cash on Beyoncé-related spending in the next 2 years, averaging \$2,500, with BeyHive members eyeing a \$3,500, on average.
- **Concert Couture**: Beyoncé's spectacles are regarded as 'otherworldly', with 64% of BeyHive and a third of fans willing to splurge \$5,000 for a ticket to her next tour.
- *Fan Sacrifices And Devotion*: From giving up alcohol, donating a kidney, to eating tarantulas, a third of BeyHive is willing to go to extremes for a chance to have a night out with Bey.
- *Harmony In Diversity*: Americans applaud Beyoncé's country leap, anticipating a new era for black artists and country music aficionados alike.
- **Beyonce's Musical Tapestry**: From posts to meetups, fans credit her melodies for cultivating deep bonds and community, with eight in 10 BeyHive reveling in shared connections.








Seven in 10 Beyoncé fans imagine spending money on the artist in the next two years, with nearly an average spend of \$2,500





Fans are happy to open their wallet for her next tour, with eight in 10 who already attended describing Beyoncé's concerts as 'otherworldly'







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




What does being a fan of a musical artist mean to you?






